

Subtitle:

"He Is Risen & I'm Forgiven"

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT THAT CHRIST IS VICTORIOUS AND RISEN?

1) Because if He did not ressurect we would still be in our sins and to be most pitied.

MARK 16:5-6

As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man, dressed in a white robe, sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed. But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed; you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here..."

2) Because If He Did not get Victory over Death, Hell and the Grave we would feel the Sting & Finality of Death (Man, death
